**COMMENTS OR SUGGESTIONS:****RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

The following rules and regulations apply to all Grand Parade applicants:

**GENERAL:**

1. Entrants must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow all instructions from police or parade officials, or be removed from the parade.
2. Individual children or groups of children, under the age of 12 (except those on motorized vehicles) will automatically be placed in the Kiddie Parade. An adult must accompany all participants under the age of 18 at all times.
3. **Throwing of ANY items by participants is forbidden during the parade as it is a danger to both the parade watchers and participants.** If caught throwing ANY items you will be asked to use the "emergency exit route" and leave the parade. You will not receive a refund of fees paid.
4. Space is limited. We reserve the right to jury any and all entries. We also reserve the right to judge all vehicles safe. Should an applicant's mode of transportation be deemed unsafe they will not be allowed to enter the parade; however, the application fee will be refunded by mail.
5. It is imperative that all parade participants stay on or near their entry during the parade.
6. Your assembly area and time will be forwarded to you in a separate letter.
7. Parade Committee decisions regarding all entries are final.

**JUDGING:**

1. The Duvall Days Grand Parade will be a judged parade.
2. The judging will be done by "roaming side-line" judges.
3. Categories will be determined by the number of entries in the different classification categories.
4. Trophies and/or ribbons will be given out on the Main Stage.

**EQUESTRIAN:**

1. No riders under 12 years of age.
2. Only one rider per horse.
3. Each rider (or group) must provide their own clean-up scooper. Any entry without a scooper will not be allowed on the parade route.
4. Any rider showing inability to control his animal will be deemed unsafe and will be removed from the parade.

**FLOATS:**

1. Drivers must remain with floats at all times and be appropriately dressed.
2. All participants riding on floats must be wearing safety belts or have hand holds while the float is moving. Floats that do not have safety belts or hand holds will not be allowed in the parade. Safety belts must be worn on the outside of garments.

**BAND AND MARCHING UNITS:**

1. All entrants must be in uniform or matching outfits.
2. If for any reason a gap of greater than 50 feet is created, marching units must increase the pace to close the gap.
3. All marching units must maintain a forward motion. Routines which cause any gaps will not be permitted. Stopping or reverse motion on the parade route will be grounds for removal.

**INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:**

1. All floats, vehicles, and equestrian entries must provide proof of insurance (necessary insurance: combined bodily injury and property damage with limits of \$100,000).
2. Floats and Equestrian Entries: Must name the Duvall Days Organization, Rotary Club of Duvall, and the City of Duvall as additionally insured.
3. Evidence of your insurance must be received by May 16.
